Get Ready for E-Soccer Season

E-Soccer is a free and INCLUSIVE soccer program for kids in the Bay Area and a new group is forming called Rising Stars. This is their youngest group for children who are 3-4 years old and will be led by one of the head coaches. **Each child in the Rising Stars group needs to be accompanied by a parent or guardian in this group.** They will have a few volunteer coaches helping out with the group, but there will not be 1-on-1 coaches.

When a child in the Rising Stars turns 5 years old, they will graduate to the 5-6 year old group. In that group 1-on-1 coaching is available as needed. This adjustment will allow them to stretch their coaching resources as far as possible and continue to build and expand their program.
